Colleen is the author of 10 books (and counting!).

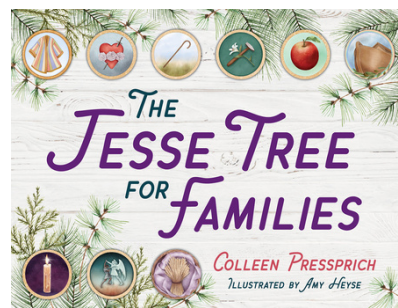
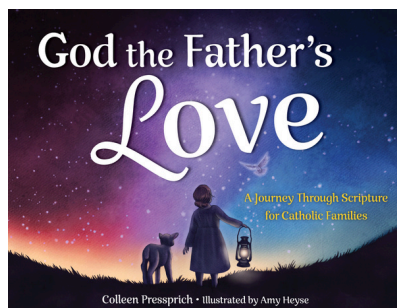
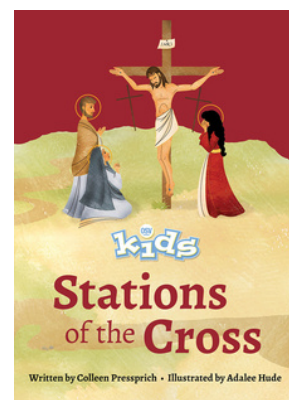
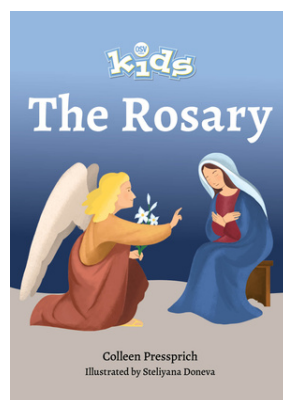
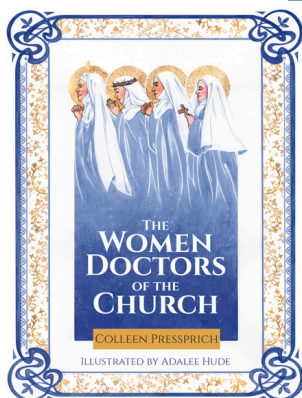
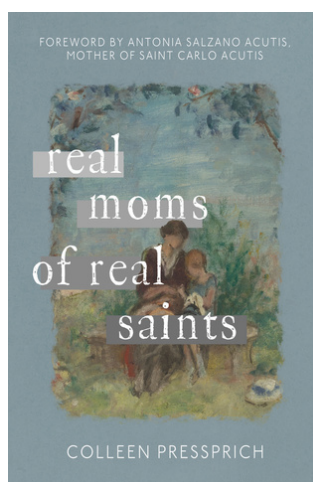

AUTHOR VISIT OPTIONS

Colleen is available for both half and full-day school events. If the visit requires driving more than an hour and a half, you'll need to include gas mileage. If driving further and needing a hotel, you'll need to include accommodation and food.

Rates are dependent on items chosen, but can be negotiated depending on school budget.

Should your kids like to purchase books ahead of the visit, Colleen is happy to offer signed copies. Just ask!

GRADES K-2 (30-45 MINUTES)

Pray the Stations of the Cross together with author-led conversation starters and discussion

Reading of 1 section of Marian Consecration for Families with Young Children with author-led conversation starters and discussion, coloring pages to go alongside.

Reading of The Women Doctors of the Church and coloring pages or rose printing craft for St. Therese

Learn about the Pope and choose a papal coloring activity.

GRADES 3-5 (45 MINUTES)

Pray the Stations of the Cross together with author-led conversation starters and discussion.

Reading of The Women Doctors of the Church with St. Catherine of Siena letter writing activity and author-led discussion about Doctors of the Church.

Presentation on the Papacy and Pope Leo XIV with activities such as designing their own papal rings and coats of arms.

AUTHOR VISIT OPTIONS

GRADES 6-8 (1 HOUR)

Pray the Stations of the Cross together with author-led conversation starters and discussion.

Learn about the Doctors of the Church and create your own prayer journal activity.

Writer's workshop based on the Stations of the Cross: the focus is on using language to evoke emotions, keeping your audience in mind, and how to give/receive critiques. Students will work on creating their own reflection for one of the Stations.

Writer's Workshop based on The Women Doctors of the Church: Focus is how to write about something important to you in a way that it becomes important to someone else, using your authorial voice, and how to give/receive critiques.

WHOLE SCHOOL RETREAT DAY (K-8)

If your school is planning a retreat to begin or end your year, consider Colleen as the keynote speaker. With her background in youth ministry and education, Colleen can speak to multiple age groups at a time in a way that is engaging.

For a whole school retreat, Colleen will come and spend the day with your kids as they are on retreat, and give a 30-minute talk on the topic of your choice, pulling in moments and memories from the day.
